

**STUDENT AUTOMOBILE USE
(REGULATIONS)**

Students who do not follow the listed rules shall lose campus-driving privileges. Vehicles should be locked when not in use. The school is not responsible for theft of personal articles in the vehicles or elsewhere. In accordance with the policy of the board of education, the following rules and regulations shall govern student parking at the public schools:

1. Students who drive vehicles to school park at their own risk and must understand that the school will not be held responsible for damage to a vehicle. Although the parking areas are monitored, students are encouraged to keep vehicles locked.
2. Students who wish to park a motor vehicle in any school parking area must register the vehicle with the school and must possess an appropriate and valid Oklahoma operator's permit or license.
3. The maximum speed on campus is ten miles per hour.
4. Students are to park only in the designated area.
5. Parking is not permitted in the fire lanes.
6. Students are to park correctly in the parking lot and not take up more than one parking space.
7. Students are not to park in restricted areas. Only the handicapped are to park in the spaces designated as "Handicapped". A permit may be obtained through the Oklahoma Department of Public Safety.
8. Once parked, student vehicles may not be driven until school is dismissed for the day unless the student is excused to leave school for the day. Students will not be allowed to return to their vehicles during break time or class time.
9. Students are not allowed to remain in their vehicles upon arrival at school. Students may not sit in, or upon, or congregate around vehicles at any time during school.
10. Vehicles shall not be driven on any grass area or upon or into any area not designated as a driveway or parking area.
11. Selling merchandise from the parking lot is prohibited.
12. Tags, bumper stickers, signs, or flags that suggest profanity, advertise tobacco or drugs, or are inflammatory or degrade another person because of race, gender, creed, or culture are prohibited.
13. All state laws, city laws, ordinances, and school rules and regulations shall be strictly enforced.
14. Stereos should be used in a manner that does not disturb school operations or neighbors. Failure to observe this regulation will be cause enough to have the student barred from driving to school.

STUDENT AUTOMOBILE USE, REGULATIONS (Cont.)

15. Student vehicles may be searched while on campus. If a student refuses to open a locked vehicle, SWTC may notify law enforcement officials who may take action to open a locked vehicle.
16. Any student in violation of any of these rules shall be suspended from operating a vehicle on school premises.
