

TRANSPORTATION MANAGEMENT

The primary responsibility and mission of Southwest Technology Center's transportation system will be to serve the needs of the district's secondary students. However, where bus capacity permits, and where there is no infringement of the service or safety provided to secondary students, post-secondary students will be permitted to utilize bus service. Arrangements for post-secondary students to ride buses may be made through the office of the director of full-time programs.

In accordance with state law, bus lights will be activated at all times any school bus is in operation.
