

EDUCATIONAL ENHANCEMENT CENTER

The educational enhancement center provides instruction for secondary and adult students who need assistance in upgrading their reading and math skills. Prior to entering a district program, students are tested to determine certain skill levels. If scores fall below a prescribed level, the educational enhancement center will provide a variety of instruction styles, which are individualized to meet the needs of the student. A student may attend the enhancement center until skills are appropriate to meet the requirements of a student's particular training program, or the enhancement center coordinator may come to the classroom to assist in that setting.. Instruction in and through the enhancement center is directly related to the career-tech program in which the student is enrolled. The enhancement center coordinates efforts with the program instructor and is a part of the student services team.
